### Barrel Location

**ATA (Jefferson MS)**, 1650 W. 22<sup>nd</sup> Street ..... In NW corner, attached to fence  
Field is to the south of the school

**Cal Young MS**, 2555 Gilham Rd ..... In SW corner, near porta-pottie  
Field is on north side of school

**Churchill HS**, 1850 Bailey Hill Rd ..... On the north fence, west of the entrance gate  
Field is west of school on 18<sup>th</sup> Street

**North Eugene HS**, 200 Silver Lane ..... Near the north end scoreboard  
Field is west of school on Silver Lane

**Sheldon HS**, 2455 Willakenzie Road ..... N. of the SE entrance gate, next to ticket booth  
Field is west of school and community center

**South Eugene HS**, 400 E. 19<sup>th</sup> Street ..... In NE corner of stadium  
Field is behind school

**Spencer Butte MS**, 500 E. 43<sup>rd</sup> St ..... In NW corner  
Field is behind school; park in east parking lot

## INFORMATION

**League Dates:** League play begins Monday, March 29 and continues through the week of June 7<sup>th</sup>.

**Score Report Forms:** Score Report Forms (blue) will be in the barrels at the fields or in the storage garage at Ascot. Please PRINT field location, all referees' names, both team's names, final score and conduct rating. Return completed form to the barrel or the storage shed.

**Barrels:** Each barrel (and the storage shed at Ascot) has in it the following: cones, small first aid kit (bandaids, tape), LRCS Supplemental Rule Book, Referee Evaluation cards, Score Sheets, Eye Wear Release forms, permanent marking pen, soccer schedules and team Line-Up sheets. Barrels on grass fields also have the nets in them.

## EXPECTATIONS

**Know City League Rules:** Please be familiar with City League modifications and refresh your memory of these rules throughout the season.

**Arrival Time:** Please arrive 15 minutes before your first scheduled game time.

**Corner Cones:** On the artificial turf fields, give cones to teams to set up on field corners. At conclusion of game, ask teams to retrieve cones and place them in the barrel.

**Check IDs:** Check each player's picture ID and mark his/her name off on the line-up sheet. For players arriving late, hold picture ID and check roster when possible (deadball, halftime, etc.). Remember, NO ID - NO PLAY - NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Begin Game On Time:** Start the game at the listed game time.

**Forfeits:** Upon mutual manager's request, officials will ref games forfeited due to teams not having the minimum number of players at game time. Please read forfeit guidelines on pages 9 in the City League Rulebook.

**Team Conduct Rating:** After the game, officials must get together and score the conduct of each team. The criteria for rating team conduct is located on the back of the Score Report form.

**Consistency In Enforcing League Rules:** When you don't enforce the rules (e.g. uniform, jewelry) you make it hard for your fellow referees to enforce the rules the following week ("...but last week the ref said it was okay."). Do your part to make sure that rules are consistently enforced for each game.

### **RULES OF EMPHASIS**

**Line-Up Sheets:** Do NOT allow anyone to play in the game if his/her name is not on the Line-Up sheet.

**Language:** For non-directed foul language - first issue a warning to the player. Be specific in your warning - "This is a warning for foul language. Next time you'll receive a yellow card." On the second offense, issue a yellow card. Note: the warning is not a team warning. Each individual player should receive a warning first prior to a yellow card for non-directed language.

**Uniforms:** Teams MUST have similarly colored uniforms with permanent numbers on them. Teams/players who do not abide by the rule cannot play. Report any such teams and players to the Athletics staff via the score report forms.

**Jewelry:** Our rulebook states that jewelry is not permitted. This includes rings, bracelets, earrings (including post or stud earrings), and necklaces. Emergency medical necklaces or bracelets may be worn but must be taped to the body. Any player found to be wearing illegal equipment will be asked to leave the playing field and cannot enter until the next dead ball.

**Eye Wear:** Players who wish to wear eye wear during a game must complete the Eye Wear Release form (located in the barrels). Put the completed form in the barrel with the line-up sheets at the completion of the game. Once a player has completed the form, the letters EW will appear on the line next to his/her name on the line-up sheets. This informs you that we have received the player's completed release form and he/she is okay to wear eye wear for the rest of the season.

**Coed Rec Goal Scoring:** Teams may opt – only with both team manager's consent – to change the rule that women's goals count as two points to all goals count as one point regardless of gender. This decision must be made prior to game start.

**Coed Rec Sideline Calls:** Teams are responsible for calling the ball out of bounds. If a call is in dispute then the referee will either make a call or issue a drop ball.
