INFORMATION

League Dates: League play begins Sunday, September 9 and continues through Wednesday, November 12.

Score Report Forms: Score Report Forms (blue) will be in the barrels at the fields. Please PRINT field location, all referees' names, team names, final score and conduct rating. Return completed form to the barrel (place in ziplock bag).

Barrels: Each barrel has in it the following: cones, small first aid kit (bandaids, tape), LRCS Supplemental Rule Book, Referee Evaluation cards, Score Sheets, permanent marking pen (for marking a number on a shirt), soccer schedules and team Line-Up sheets.

Lights: If you are having a problem with the lights (lights don't go on, game is expected to run past 10 PM, etc.) call Janet or Dave. Phone numbers are in the ziplock bag in the barrel.

EXPECTATIONS

Know City League Rules: Please be familiar with City League modifications and refresh your memory of these rules throughout the season.

Arrival Time: Please arrive 15 minutes before your first scheduled game time.

Corner Cones: On the artificial turf fields, please give cones to teams to set up on field corners. At conclusion of game, please ask teams to retrieve cones and place them in the barrel. Please don't forget to place the completed score report form in the barrel before leaving the game site.

- OVER -

Check IDs: Check each player's picture ID, and mark his/her name off on the line-up sheet. For players arriving late, hold picture ID and check roster when possible (deadball, halftime, etc.). Remember: **NO ID - NO PLAY - NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Begin Game On Time: Please start the game at the listed game time. On weekdays, the high schools have use of the field until 8:00 PM. If your City League game follows a high school game which is running late, please get the City League game started as soon after the HS game as possible. To facilitate this, check IDs on the sidelines prior to 8 PM. Teams may stretch and warm-up on the sidelines but must be on the opposite side of the HS team benches during a HS game.

Forfeits: Upon mutual manager's request, officials will officiate games forfeited due to teams not having the minimum number of players at game time. Please read forfeit guidelines on pages 9 in the City League Rulebook.

Team Conduct Rating: After the game, officials must get together and score the conduct of each team. The criteria for rating team conduct is located on the back of the Score Report form.

Consistency In Enforcing League Rules: When you don't enforce the rules (e.g. uniform, jewelry) you make it hard for your fellow referees to enforce the rules the following week ("...but last week the ref said it was okay."). Do your part to make sure that rules are consistently enforced for each game.

RULES OF EMPHASIS

Line-Up Sheets: Do NOT allow anyone to play in the game if his/her name is not on the Line-Up sheet.

Language: For non-directed foul language - first issue a warning to the player. Be specific in your warning - "This is a warning for foul language. Next time you'll receive a yellow card." On the second offense, issue a yellow card. Note: the warning is not a team warning. Each individual player should receive a warning first prior to a yellow card for non-directed language.

Uniforms: Teams MUST have similar colored uniforms with numbers on either the front or back by the FIRST league game. Teams/players who do not abide by the rule cannot play. Report any such teams and players to the Athletics staff via the score report forms.

Jewelry: Our rulebook states that jewelry is not permitted. This includes rings, bracelets, earrings (including post or stud earrings), and necklaces. Emergency medical necklaces or bracelets may be worn but must be taped to the body.

Eye Wear: Players wishing to wear Eye Wear (prescription glasses or goggles) during games must complete a waiver form prior to playing. Waiver forms are available in the barrels at all of the fields. Please place the completed waiver form with the score sheets in the barrel to ensure that the waiver form gets back to our office. Once the waiver form has been turned in to our office, we will pen an "EW" next to their name on the team roster. If you see an "EW" next to a player's name on a roster, this means that we have their waiver form on file and they are allowed to play with Eye Wear.
